translucent, trans-lö'-sent

Allowing light to pass through, but not so as to render the form or color of objects beyond distinctly visible.

Translate translucent properties to spray color and you've got Home Décor Stain. A unique stain/glaze that transforms color of most hard surfaced items. Spray Home Décor Stain over natural-colored unfinished surfaces and the object becomes the color of the spray. Spray over a colored surface and the object's color shifts, with the base color visually mixing with the stain color.

Think of using Home Décor Stain in much the same way you use the favored GLOSSY WOOD TONE, as a misting of it veils the item with an antique-like glaze. With Home Décor Stain you have more choices to layer colors and enrich the surface. Another property of translucency translated to Home Décor Stains allows you to control color intensity. Applying more coats of stain, deepens the color value.

COLOR techniques



TECHNIQUE ONE:

1. For unfinished wood surfaces, spray **Home Décor Stain** liberally 6"-8" from surface until wet and glossy.
2. Immediately wipe stain with a soft cloth to enhance the wood grain.



Note: If stain dries before wiping, re-wet the surface with more stain and wipe.

3. Even the color or deepen its intensity by applying additional light coats of stain. Now, hold can 12"-15" from surface and apply in steady sweeping motions. Do Not Wipe. Let dry between coats.



TECHNIQUE TWO:

1. For non-wood surfaces, spray light coats of stain without wiping, using steady sweeping motions, 12"-15" from surface.
2. Add coats to build the intensity of color.



UNIQUE TECHNIQUE:

1. To highlight relief patterns or basket weaves, apply stain and wipe while wet.
2. Use **Mess Master Spray** as an alternative wiping agent. Simply spray it into a cloth and wipe over previously stained relief areas. Rewet cloth as needed.
